**‘Fuchsia’ is in very good condition for her year, as she was refurbished in 2019. New cream leatherette cushion covers were renewed throughout the cabin, and the aft deck, and the cabin also had a new ceiling lining fitted.**

Inside she has a 2-burner cooker and grill, stainless steel sink unit with a pumped water system, together with a new fridge fitted in 2018. The main living area is open plan with dining area opposite the sink which converts to a double berth, as well as a further 2 berths in the bow V section.

The bathroom has a porta-loo toilet. There are a good supply of storage lockers and cupboards.

On the outside of the Boat, the canopy is in good condition, and under which there is further upholstered seating across the stern.

She has a Tohatsu 15 hp, 4 stroke Outboard which was new in 2020 and has been serviced, with a new start battery fitted at the same time.

The Hull is the original gel coat (not painted), which has been polished. She was last out of water in 2018. There are good mooring ropes/fenders all round. Also includes 12-v and 240-v electrics.

The Boat is in good condition and is very well equipped and has many extras ..... must be seen. For Sale due to current owner’s health problems.
