The main living area is open plan with dining area opposite the sink which converts to a double berth, as well as a further 2 berths in the bow V section.

The bathroom has a porta-loo toilet.

The boat is well equipped with storage lockers and cupboards.

Also includes 12- and 240-volt electrics.

Very recently new cream leatherette cushion covers have been fitted in the cabin, as well as the aft deck. A new ceiling lining has also been fitted in the cabin.

On the outside the Boat has an excellent canopy under which there is further upholstered seating across the stern.



The Hull is all original gelcoat (not painted), which has been polished. Also has new mooring ropes.
